Finding and borrowing books and journals

The Lady Smith of Kelvin Veterinary Library holds the University's current veterinary
collections and collections to support the Roslin Institute and the Global Academy
of Agriculture and Food Security. Some veterinary books are also available in the
HUB Collection in the Main Library.

Older print journals and book collections for veterinary medicine are held in the
University Collections Facility.

Edinburgh University Library provides access to a wide range of resources
including books, e-books, e-journals, databases and theses.

DiscoverEd

You can use DiscoverEd to search for books, journal titles and e-books and to
self-request items, renew loans and manage your Library account. Use University
login details to sign into DiscoverEd to access e-resources and to manage your
Library account: <https://discovered.ed.ac.uk>

How many lending items may I borrow and for how long?

Self-issue machines and a self-return machine are available in the library.
You will need your University card to use them.

* Staff and Postgraduate standard loan period is 12 weeks with a maximum
renewal period of 18 months.

** unless you have fines over £10 or the item has been recalled by another user.

Renewals: you can renew items already on loan to you via DiscoverEd by using
'My Account' tab, or by visiting or phoning the library's Helpdesk.

Recalls: books out on loan may be recalled for use by another user. The fine for
overdue recalled books is £1 per day.

Holds: e-mail notification is sent out when a book is returned to the library.

Study space

The library has a large number of study spaces with access to the University Network for personal laptop computers. There is an adjustable height desk with accessible PC and a standing height desk. There are also open access computers, a quick use PC, a DiscoverEd search point and a visitor kiosk in the Library.

Edinburgh University staff and students may connect to the wireless network by activating the University Wi-Fi account at www.ed.ac.uk/is/wireless from an open access computer.

Edinburgh University Alumni may also activate the University Wi-Fi account, please ask at the Library Helpdesk and also see www.ed.ac.uk/alumni/services/portal for further help if you do not have University login details.

Printing, photocopying and scanning

A printer/photocopier/scanner is available in the library. Printing and scanning facilities are also located in the nearby Study Landscape.

A poster printer is also available in the library. This can print A0, A1 and A2 posters.

Edinburgh University students and staff pay for printing and photocopying with their print credit account. You can credit your account using the Online Print Credit channel on MyEd at: www.myed.ed.ac.uk

Print credit may also be added at the Library Helpdesk.

Subject searching

If you want to research a topic but do not have a list of references try:

Literature databases

The library subscribes to a wide range of literature databases which provide indexes to the world's academic literature. Covering primarily journal articles and conference papers these databases are best searched through their specialist interface. DiscoverEd

DiscoverEd is the Library's discovery service. Use it to search the Library's collections: this includes books, e-books, journal titles, journal articles, databases and more. Use University login details to sign into your Library Account and manage loans, requests and fines.

Please note that DiscoverEd does not search across CAB Abstracts, VetMed Resource and Global Health.

Can't find what you're looking for?

Contact the library's Helpdesk as they may be able to help you find what you are looking for or find an alternative source of information.

You may request books and journal articles from other Edinburgh University Library sites, including the University Collections Facility via DiscoverEd. There is no charge for this delivery service.

Standard and short loan books that are out on loan can be recalled through DiscoverEd.

Use DiscoverEd to search for a required title, select a pickup location and submit the request.

For requesting journal articles and other material that we do not hold in the library, you can use the Interlibrary Loan Service (ILL) by submitting requests via DiscoverEd using the form for interlibrary loan requests situated above the search bar:

You will need to log into DiscoverEd with your University login details, before you can access the form.
