

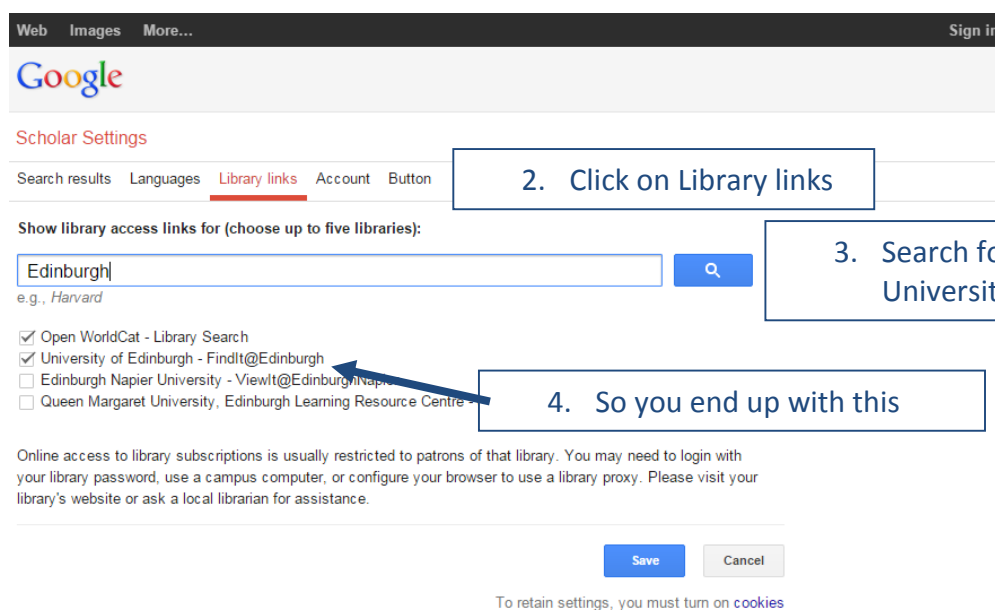
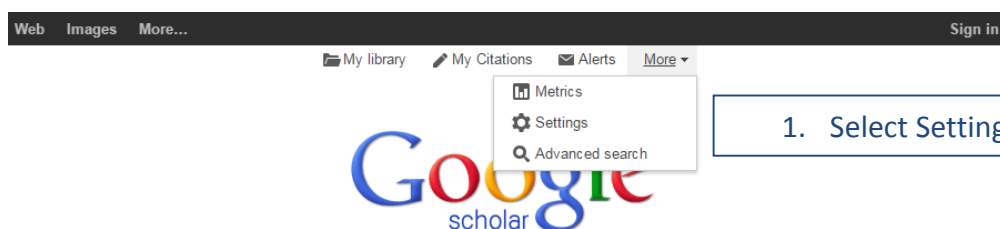
Google Scholar: Accessing full text papers

The University of Edinburgh Library has arranged to have links to full text online journal subscriptions available in your Google Scholar search results.

Google Scholar is available from <http://scholar.google.co.uk/>

Change the settings to link to University of Edinburgh online journal subscriptions with the following steps:

1. Select Settings
2. Click on Library Links
3. Search for Edinburgh and select University of Edinburgh
4. Save the settings



When you then search in Google Scholar, you will see 'FindIt@Edinburgh' links to the right-hand side of your search results where we have online access. The system isn't perfect – if you don't see 'FindIt@Edinburgh' it is still worth checking DiscoverEd for the journal title where you may still find print holdings or online access:
