

Viewing presentations and lecture recordings in Media Hopper Replay

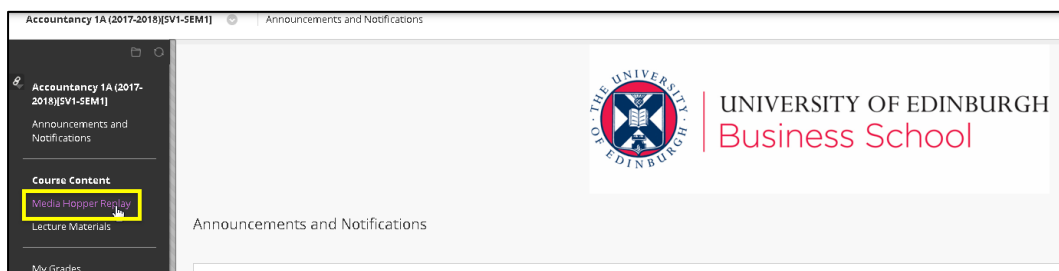
Media Hopper Replay allows you to view presentation files uploaded by your lecturer before, during or after the lecture. Video recordings of the lecture will become available as soon as your lecturer has released them to your course for you to view.

Opening and viewing a presentation file

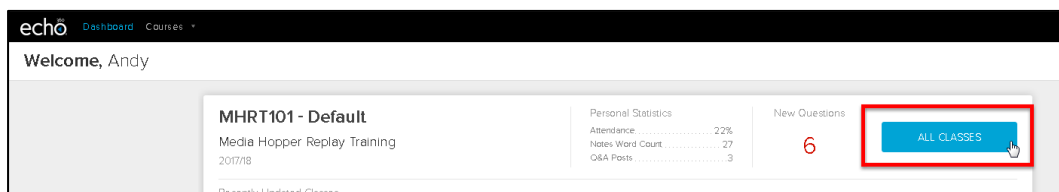
If your lecturer uploads and makes available a copy of their presentation before their lecture takes place, you will be able to open and view it within Media Hopper Replay. This allows you to open the presentation on your on device during the lecture and take electronic notes against it. These notes will also be visible when you view the lecture recording and can be downloaded as text file.

To open and view a presentation file:

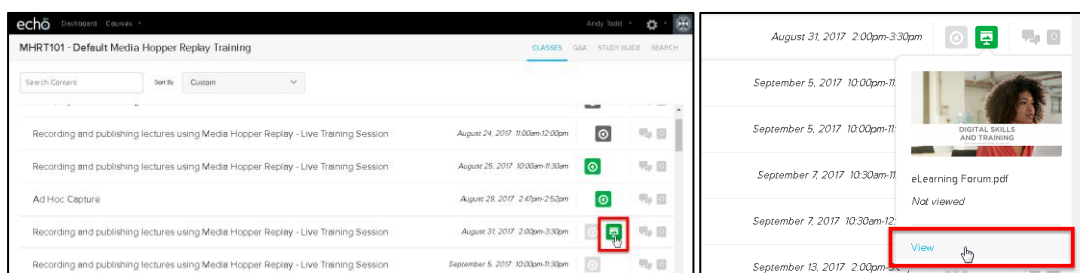
1. Log into Learn or Moodle (whichever is used for your course) and open the course you wish to view the lecture recording or presentation for.
2. Click on the **Media Hopper Replay** link either located in the menu on the left or within the main course area to open Media Hopper Replay.



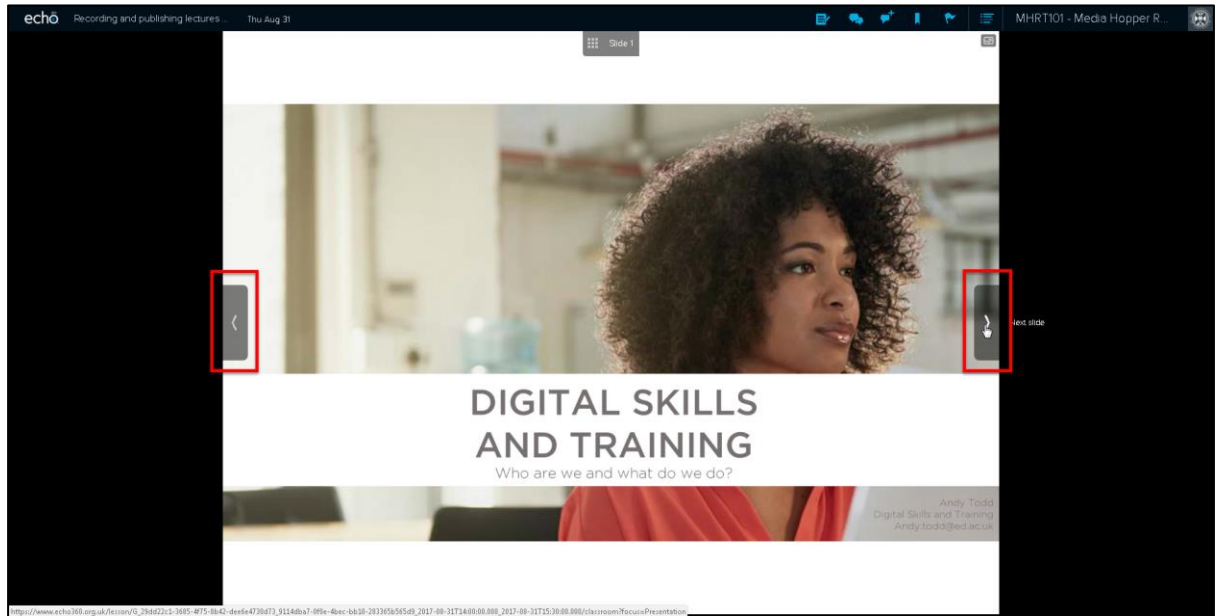
3. When Replay opens, click on the **All Classes** button within the course you wish to open. This will take you into the course and show you all of your past and future classes. You can get back to this view by clicking on the **Dashboard** button at the top left.



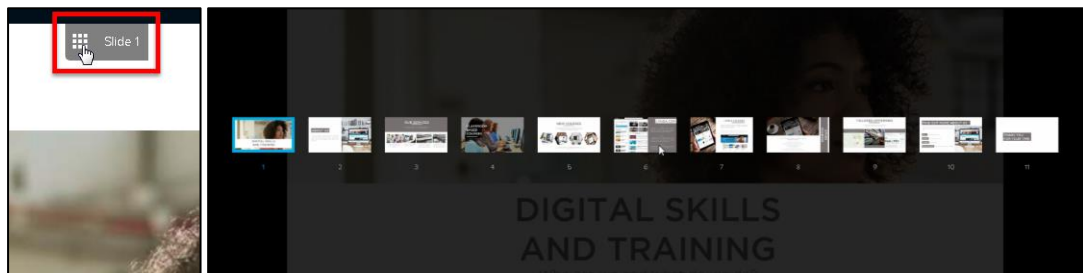
4. Click on the green **Presentation** button for the presentation file you would like to open, and select **View** from the list to open it. A green coloured icon means you have not viewed the content yet, with a dark grey icon meaning you have.



- Your presentation will now open. To move through the slides, use the **Previous** and **Next** slide buttons to the left and right of the presentation.



- To view all slides so you can jump between them, click on the **Show all** button at the top of the presentation and select the slide you wish to jump to.

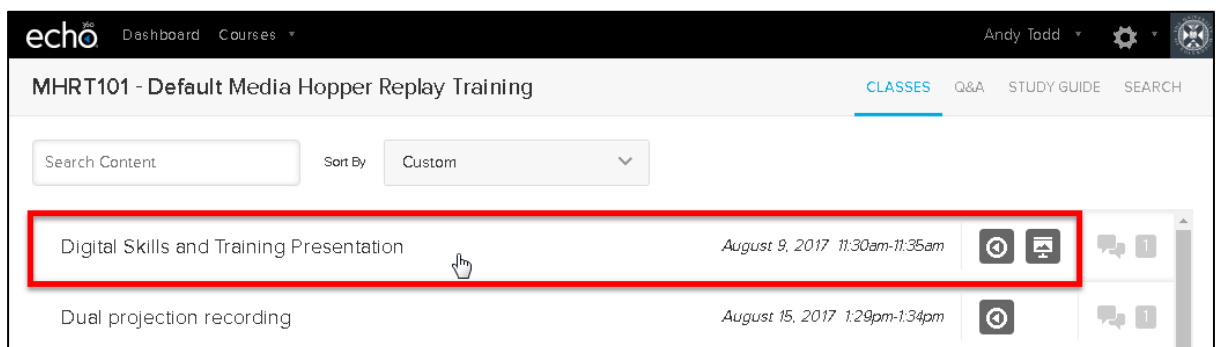


Opening and viewing a lecture recording

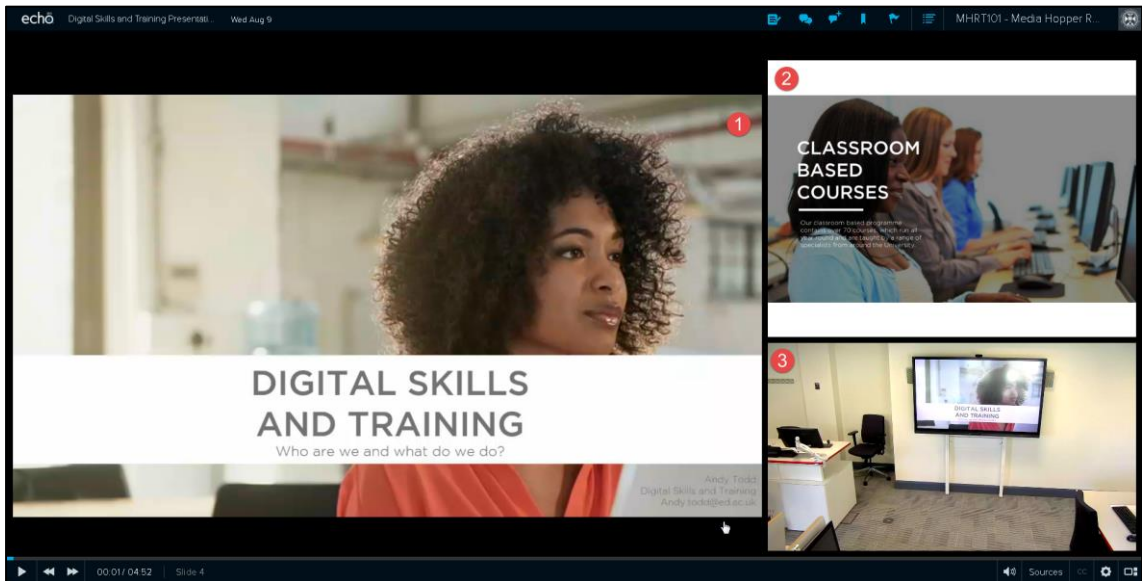
Once your lecturer has released a lecture recording to your course, you will be able to open and view it. As the viewer, you have a range of playback options available to you such as quality, speed, source selection and source layout.

To open and view a lecture recording:

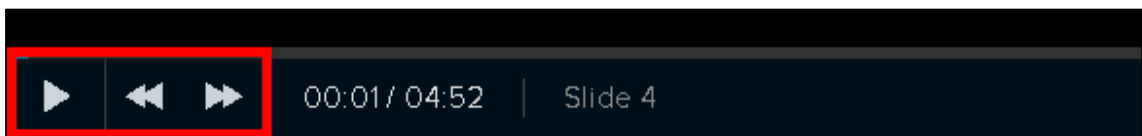
- Locate the class containing the lecture recording you wish to view. In the example below, a lecture recording and presentation are available to view together. Click on the name of the class to open and view them.



Your lecture recording will now open on screen. In this example, the recording contains the feed from your lecturer's computer (1), the presentation they uploaded (2) and the camera recording from within the lecture theatre (3).

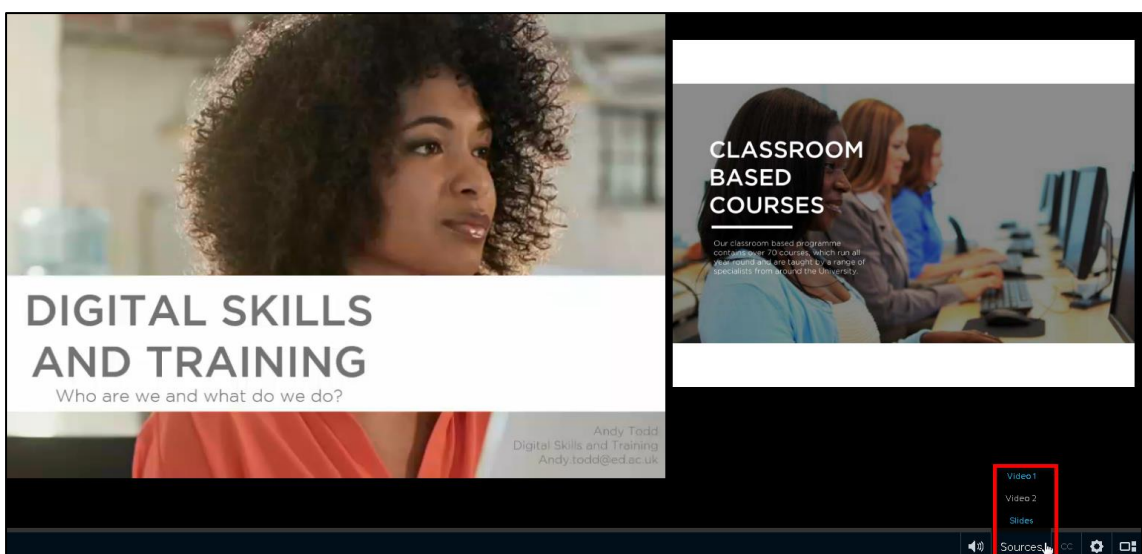


- To control the playback of the video, use the **Play**, **Forward** and **Backward** buttons below the video.

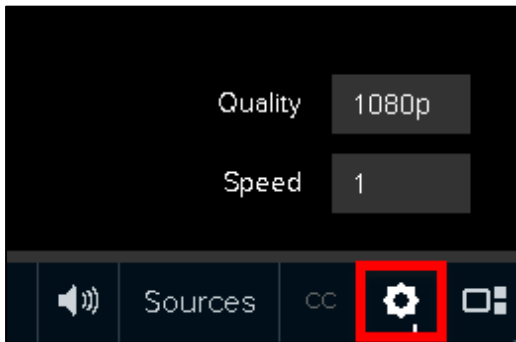


- You can choose which of the sources you wish to view when watching the recording using the **Sources** button. The default is to display all at the same time but you can turn sources off by clicking on them (blue means they are visible, white means they are not).

Below, the Video 2 source has been toggled off so the camera feed from the lecture room is no longer visible during playback. Selecting it again will redisplay this source.



- The **Playback Settings** options can be used to change the quality from 1080p to 480p (perfect if your video keeps buffering due to a slow connection), or to change the speed at which you video plays back (between x0.5 and x2).



- If you wish to change how the video sources look on screen, use the **Arrange Sources** to select the view that suits you best. Just remember this will only arrange sources you have displayed, so any you've hidden will need to be made visible again before you can see them.
