

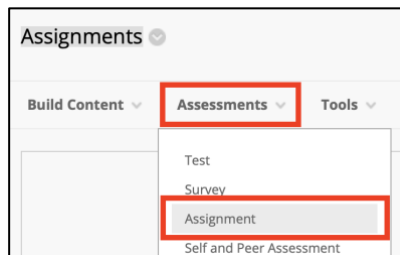
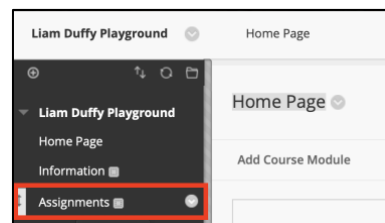
# Media Hopper Create

## Creating a media assignment drop-box in Learn

To allow students to submit media content from their Media Hopper Create account to your Learn course, you will first have to create an assignment drop-box within Learn.

You will need to be an Instructor on the course you wish to add the assignment to.

1. Open the Content Area (from the **Course Menu**) where you would like to place the assignment. In the example below, a content area called 'Assignments' has been created.
2. Click on **Assessments** and select **Assignment**.



The **Create Assignment** page will now open. Some of the fields are mandatory (marked with \*) and some optional. The table below contains a brief explanation of the main options found on the form.

<b>Name and Colour*</b>	The title of the assignment that students will see in the assignments list for their class.
<b>Assignment Files</b>	Allows the instructor to attach a file with instructions.
<b>Due date</b>	Submissions are accepted after this date, but are marked as Late.
<b>Marking*</b>	A value must be entered for points possible.
<b>Associated Rubric</b>	A rubric can be added or created here and the option to show the rubric to the student is also set here.

3. Enter a name for the assignment in the **Name and Colour** field.
4. In the **Instructions** box type “**To submit a video file, first click on the Write Submission button within the assignment. When the text editor opens, click on Add Content ‘+’ symbol and select Media Hopper Create Media from the list**”.
5. In the **Marking** box enter the number of points possible, for example, 100. This is a mandatory field, so cannot be left blank.
6. Use the **Due Dates** option to set a due date for the assignment.
7. Leave all other settings as they are.
